PERCEIVE LIKE GOD

Ephesians 6:12 (KJV) *“For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.”*

Ephesians 6:12 (AMP) *“For we are not wrestling with flesh and blood (contending only with physical opponents), but against the despotisms (abuse of power), against the powers, world rulers of this present darkness, against the spirit forces of wickedness in the heavenly (supernatural) sphere.”*

- To perceive like God, **you have to see it like God**_____.
- That means we don't perceive in our flesh (we wrestle not against flesh)
- But we must be discerning in the Spirit.
 - **Jeremiah 29:11 (KJV)** *“For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end.”*
 - **Isaiah 48:17 (KJV)** *“Thus saith the LORD, thy Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel; I am the LORD thy God which teacheth thee to profit, which leadeth thee by the way that thou shouldest go.”*
- God wants us to go after the _____, not after the flesh.
 - **II Corinthians 10:3-5 (KJV)** *“For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war after the flesh: **4** (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;) **5** Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;”*
- Praying in the Spirit is essential for purging and purity.
 - **Romans 8:26-27 (KJV)** *“Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. **27** And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to the will of God.”*
 - **Proverbs 4:23 (KJV)** *“Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life.”*



ACT LIKE GOD

Galatians 5:19-23 (KJV) *"Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, 20 Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies, 21 Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God. 22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, 23 Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law."*

Galatians 5:19-21 (AMP) *"Now the doings (practices) of the flesh are clear (obvious): they are immorality, impurity, indecency, idolatry, sorcery, enmity, strife, jealousy, anger (ill temper), selfishness, divisions (dissensions), party spirit (factions, sects with peculiar opinions, heresies), envy, drunkenness, carousing, and the like. I warn you beforehand, just as I did previously, that those who do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God."*

- Works of the flesh _____ inherit the kingdom of God
- **Whoever you act like - that you will be.**
- Practices of the flesh - "...its all about me!"
- The Bible says... **Matthew 7:16** *"Ye shall know them by their fruits..."*
- When you act like God, then God _____ with you.
- Just the opposite applies...when you act like Satan, then Satan associates himself with you.

Isaiah 61:3 (AMP) *"To grant (consolation and joy) to those who mourn in Zion - to give them an ornament (a garland or diadem) of beauty instead of ashes, the oil of joy instead of mourning, the garment (expressive) of praise instead of a heavy, burdened, and failing spirit - that they may be called oaks of righteousness lofty, strong, and magnificent, distinguished for uprightness, justice and right standing with God), the planting of the Lord, that He may be glorified."*

- God gives you a garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness.
- Get dressed with praise.
- My spirit must refuse to worry.

Romans 4:17 (AMP) *"As it is written, I have made you the father of many nations. (He was appointed our father) in the sight of God in Whom he believed, Who gives life to the dead and speaks of the non-existent things that (He has foretold and promised) as if they (already existed)."*

- We need to call things that are not _____
- Demonstrate the fruit of the spirit (ACT like God)



- Mark of maturity is to walk with joy!

THE HARVEST OR RESULTS

Galatians 6:7 (AMP) *“Do not be deceived and deluded and misled; God will not allow Himself to be sneered at (scorned, disdained, or mocked by mere pretensions or professions, or by His precepts being set aside), (He inevitably deludes himself who attempts to delude God). For whatever a man sows, that and that only is what he will reap.”*

- Whatever you plant is what you get. (What You Speak, What you Think, What You Perceive and How you Act) These are all seeds!
- You cannot plant seeds of _____ and expect _____.
- You cannot plant seeds of doubt and expect FAITH!
- You have the power to change whatever seed you have in your _____!
- The Holy Ghost that is within us allows us to overcome and dictates our day.
- WE MUST PRAY IN THE HOLY GHOST, we can not do it by ourselves.

I Corinthians 14:2 (AMP) *“For one who speaks in an (unknown) tongue speaks not to men but to God, for no one understands or catches his meaning, because in the (Holy) Spirit he utters secret truths and hidden things (not obvious to the understanding).”*

I Corinthians 14:4 (AMP) *“He who speaks in a (strange) tongue edifies and improves himself, but he who prophesies (interpreting the divine will and purpose and teaching with inspiration) edifies and improves the church and promotes growth (in Christian wisdom, piety, holiness and happiness).”*

Galatians 6:9 (AMP) *“And let us not lose heart and grow weary and faint in acting nobly and doing right, for in due time and at the appointed season we shall reap, if we do not loosen and relax our courage and faint.”*

- Jesus was tempted at the end of His fast.
- This is why the devil wants you to quit, he does not want you to receive God’s harvest!

Galatians 6:10 (AMP) *“So then, as occasion and opportunity open up to us, let us do good (morally) to all people (not only being useful or profitable to them, but also doing what is for their spiritual good and advantage). Be mindful to be a blessing, especially to those of the household of faith (those who belong to God’s family with you, the believers).*
